

The Cause for Price Decreases at Walgreens: Inflation?



Average price increases in the Personal Hygiene category were 11% at Target, 21% at Walmart, 8% at CVS in the last 18 months, while Walgreens saw a drop of 10%.

It seems Walgreens - known for higher-priced staples - may have had to adapt to market changes with price decreases.



In a head to head match up of prices for the same products at CVS and Walgreens, Walgreens products are currently slightly less expensive than CVS' prices, but at the cost of massive drops in price.
